

The Port of Port Angeles has been working to diligently to preserve commercial service at William R. Fair-child International Airport for many years. To that end we applied for and received a grant to market our commercial carrier, Kenmore Air Express and our community. This is one of many tools we will implement to sustain commercial operations and we thank everyone that has or will be assisting us as we proceed forward with this effort.

As all of you are aware we have been working for a number of years to implement a new approach procedure to runway 26. With a new approach procedure it will significantly reduce the time and fuel consumption under instrument approach procedures (reducing hydrocarbon emissions, reducing operational costs and improving the customer experience). We are in the final stages of our Airport Master Plan process and we are requesting community support for the implementation of a new approach to runway 26. If you have an interest in supporting a new approach to runway 26 I have included a Draft Template letter for your use if you would like to provide input to the Federal Aviation Administration.
