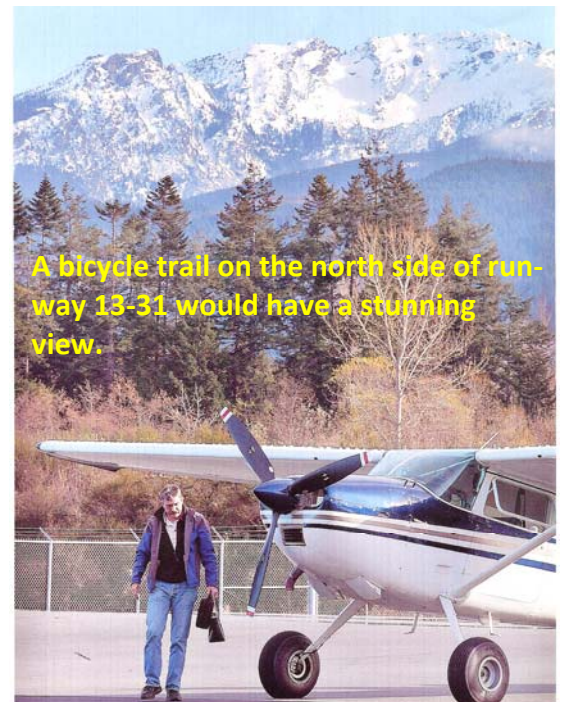

### AT OUR NEXT MEETING . . . . .

We will be examining the proposal made at our last meeting to put a loop bicycle trail around the entire airport (KCLM). This is a complicated project that could eventually involve three of our local governmental agencies. Fortunately, we only have to deal with the Port of Port Angeles during the initial stages. In fact the Port could establish over 90% of the loop without either the city or the county getting involved. However, we want both the city and county to at least have a heads up on this. It might just put additional pressure on the city to take those trees down in Lincoln Park.

To make things even more complicated, we may want to involve folks from the Peninsula Trails Coalition (PTC) and the Alternate Transportation Advocacy of Port Angeles (ATAPA). If grants are needed, these folks may provide some important knowledge on the subject. If we think about it, the "Pilots Loop Bicycle Trail" might provide something rather unique to William Fairchild International. Placing a Loop around the airport might bring more business to the airport since it would attract not only bicycle riders, but joggers, dog walkers, hikers, and recumbent bike and trike users. Since so many presently use the ODT for recreational purposes, the loop will offer these folks another unusual recreational opportunity.

At the April 17 meeting (at Coldwell Banker) we will discuss the north and east sides of this loop. At the May 15 meeting we could discuss the south and west sides of this loop. At the June 19 meeting we could meet at Rite Bros and take a tour of the loop looking at what could be critical stumbling blocks. When we reach these places, we'll be able to discuss all possible solu-



tions.

We don't want to miss you. So please come to our April 17 meeting and bring with you anyone that may be interested in this proposed project. It would be great if we could interest those pilots who are hangared at KCLM, but don't come to our CCPA meetings.

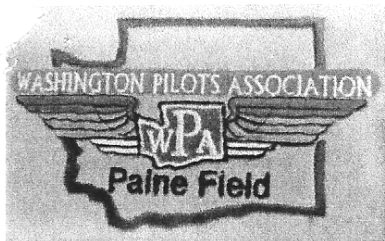

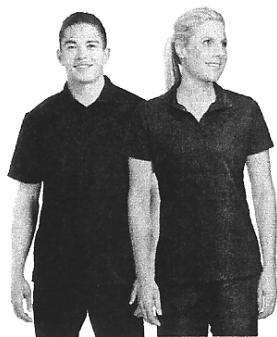
