**A Hot Air Balloon Demonstration

CCPA is most fortunate to have Captain Crystal give us a live balloon demonstration at our July CCPA meeting at Rite Bros. Of course it isn't as sure a thing as it sounds because weather, wind velocity, and direction are the major factors that a balloon pilot must keep track of before even inflating a hot air balloon.

It's quite an experience to watch all the steps of inflation, and launching. Before even unpacking the balloon, small balloons are periodically released to test local wind direction and speed. The whole process can be quite detailed and can easily take over an hour or more. Launching is extremely chancy, much more so than the take-off of a powered aircraft.

It should be remembered that ballooning is not an inexpensive hobby. Capt Crystal will be going to a great deal of effort and some expense to put on this demonstration. So let's get the word out and make this our best attended meeting so far this year. Look for us in the open field south of the Newport Hangar which is southwest of:
