The Port Angeles High School NJROTC program is one of the best in Washington State, and has also won national recognition .

Captain Jon Picker (retired) will give us a presentation on the Naval Junior Reserve Officer Training Corp, a program that emphasizes citizenship, leadership, and management. He will review how this program tries to reach these goals and what sort of activities he organizes. About 1/3 of his graduates enlist in one of the armed services, about 1/3 continue on with college, and 1/3 obtain employment in some sort of job. The NJROTC program at our high school is an excellent precursor for

college ROTC.

Some of us retired folks can remember when getting an appointment to one of the military academies required a recommendation from a senator. At the same time two years of ROTC training used to be a requirement at any Land Grant university. Evidently, things have changed a bit with getting an ROTC scholarship being more difficult to obtain now and appointments to any one of the four military academies, a bit easier. The local NJROTC program can smooth the way to a college ROTC scholarship.

And what about flying and flight training? Captain Picker is up to date about the EAA Young Eagles Program. He tries to determine who might be interested in becoming a Young Eagle, and has had a number of his present students involved in this program. He is also aware of the fact that there is a critical shortage of commercial pilots. Of course he keeps track of who is interested in aviation and he is always looking for ways to interest his students in such.

We suspect that Captain Picker has some great stories to tell about his experiences in both the service and the present NJROTC program. So mark your calendars for May 18. We don't want to miss you.

# FAA RELEASES THIRD CLASS MEDICAL REFORM FINAL RULE REGULATIONS EFFECTIVE MAY 1

The FAA has released a final rule on third class medical reform, though it will be several months before pilots can fly under the new program that the agency has named BasicMed.

## At a Glance

### Medical reform highlights

**Aircraft specifications:** Up to six seats, up to 6,000 pounds (no limitations on horsepower, number of engines, or gear type)

**Flight rules:** Day or night, VFR or IFR

**Passengers:** Up to five passengers

**Aeromedical factors:** Pilots must take a free online course every two years and visit their personal physician every four years

**Altitude restriction:** Up to 18,000 feet msl

**Airspeed limitation:** 250 knots indicated airspeed

**Pilot limitation:** Cannot operate for compensation or hire

**It is now May and if you want to be able to fly, you'll have to fly under Basic Med.**
