Learning to interpret the weather while in-flight and possibly determine how it might be changing.

Weather Theory, essentially how air changes (temperature, moisture, and stability) as it moves around in the atmosphere.

Lots and lots of cloud images to learn how clouds can indicate what the atmosphere is doing. Also, how important it is to get good background weather information before flying, and how to apply this inflight analysis to the pre-flight weather briefing.
