## Modification of Class B Airspace; Seattle, WA

Effective Date: 0901 UTC, December 15, 2011. The Director of the Federal Register approves this incorporation by reference action under 1 CFR part 51, subject to the annual revision of FAA Order 7400.9 and publication of conforming amendment

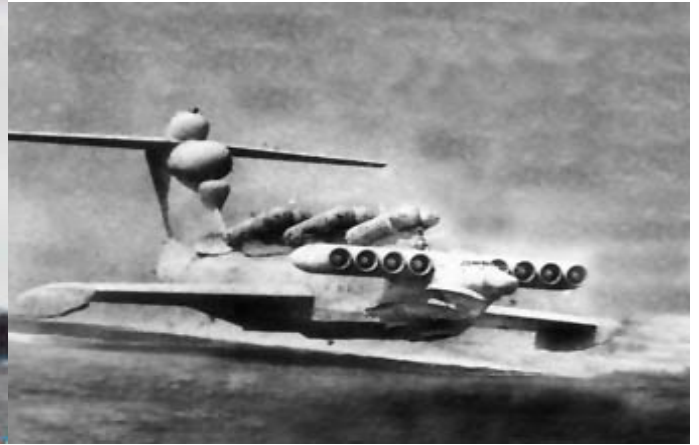
The FAA is amending 14 CFR part 71 to modify the Seattle, WA, Class B airspace area. This action (depicted on the attached chart) reduces the overall size of the Seattle Class B airspace by approximately 194 square miles and incorporates two different ceiling altitudes. The rule expands the eastern Class B boundary to ensure containment of turbojet aircraft, but eliminates unnecessary outer (arrival route) wings that currently extend to 30 NM. Where possible, certain Class B boundaries are aligned with existing VORTAC and geographical features resulting in improved boundary definition.
