Kurt Mason Aviation Education Scholarship

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Saturday, March 30, 2013 (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
- 3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 4. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
- 5. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you. You may also download a copy of the application online at http://www.wpaflys.org/Chapters/Paine/index.htm
- 6. You will be notified by mail or email in May regarding the status of your application.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution or flight school.

Purpose: To provide a \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving student seeking education and career opportunities in aviation or aerospace fields.

Criteria:

- 1. Be a U.S. Citizen or legal resident.
- 2. Be enrolled (or accepted) in an accredited college, university, or flight school as an undergraduate in one of the following programs:
 - a. Flight training program
 - b. Accredited college or university for an aviation degree
 - c. Accredited college for Airframe & Powerplant certification
 - d. Aerospace labor training program
- 3. Demonstrate financial need.
- 4. Have an enrollment status equal to at least a half-time (6 credit hrs) student or be enrolled as a flight training student.
- 5. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or show satisfactory flight training progress.

Application Process:

- 1. Applicant must submit the following items:
 - a. Completed scholarship application form.
 - b. A two page, double-spaced essay, describing your academic and career goals and explaining why you are interested in pursuing a pilot certificate or degree in aviation.
- 2. Participate in a live interview (if selected from qualifying applications).

Deadline for the application is **Saturday**, **March 30**, **2013**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
